JANUARY 20: SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME **Readings: Is 62:1-5/1 Cor 12:4-11/Jn 2:1-11** Both the first reading and the Gospel use wedding imagery: God rejoices in Israel just as a bridegroom rejoices in his bride. Jesus inaugurates his ministry at the wedding of Cana. This gospel is rich in details: Mary alerting Jesus to the lack of wine, and then telling the servants to do whatever he tells them. The empty water jars to be filled with water which Jesus will turn into wine. The superabundance (more than 120 gallons!) of the most excellent wine and the fact that this first sign or miracle lets the disciples begin to believe in Jesus. How have we experienced the abundance of God? How do we share this good news with others?
